

Windom's Fall

Clean-Up

Saturdays, September 21 & 28

The City of Windom is conducting the 2013 Citywide Clean-up on Sept. 21 and 28. Refer to the map below for the correct pick-up date. Items placed on the curb on the wrong day will not be picked up.

PLACE ITEMS AT THE CURB IN SEPARATE PILES BY 6:00 A.M. DO NOT PLACE ITEMS IN ALLEY.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ALLOWED FOR PICK-UP:

- Household Goods
- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Other items too bulky to be placed in a garbage bag.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS INCLUDE:

- Hazardous Waste
- Liquid Waste
- Used Oil
- Concrete
- Lead Acid Batteries
- Fluorescent Tubes
- Appliances & Electronics*
- Building Materials
- Paints
- Auto Bodies
- Tires
- Garbage

NO LEAVES, TREES, DIRT OR GRASS CLIPPINGS will be picked up during this clean-up. Leaves and grass clippings can be taken to the Compost Site which is open Tuesdays from 4 to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Trees, branches, brush, etc. (no grass clippings) can be taken to the landfill daily from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and the first and third Saturdays from 8 a.m. to noon.

APPLIANCES & ELECTRONICS:

Appliances and electronics can be picked up for an additional charge. Tags to pick up these items must be purchased at City Hall by Sept. 19 for the Sept. 21 pick-up or by Sept. 26 for the Sept. 28 pickup.

The cost to recycle these items is \$10 for each appliance and \$20 for each electronic item.


Appliances include: Refrigerator, stove/oven, washer, dryer, microwave, water heater, freezer, window air conditioner.

Electronics include: Television, computer, monitor, computer processor, printer, fax, copier, stereo, VCR.

Any piles intermixed with other than what has been specified WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

Any articles put out after the crews have gone by WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
