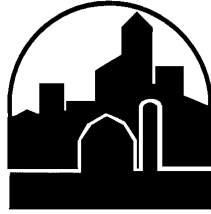

- **Arena** – The wild horse and burro sale went very well.

- **Telecom** – Gove acres fiber install rough-in. Have car wash service to install fiber to site.
- **Liquor** – July 4th weekend very busy and had product shortages. Did over \$52,000 in sales.
- **Water\Wastewater** – Automatic Systems doing some work on the WWTP and painters are on-site. Well #11 now operational.
- **Police** – Busy.
- **Economic Development Authority** – SW Minnesota Housing Partnership would like to do a modular housing project maybe on the Kruse property, but work needs to be done to address the stormwater issues.
- **Library** – A\C repaired. Shelving is now scheduled in mid-August. Dawn on vacation July 19.
- **Electric** – Gove Acres will be energized today. Car wash electric rough in this week. May need to reconsider turbine as replacement on-site with diesel generation may cause air emissions issues.
- **Building\Zoning** – Revised floodplain ordinance on for Council review. Minor subdivision for the Kelly property on Co. Road 26 going to Council for approval. Busy with nuisance properties.
- **Streets & Parks** – Crew working on 6th Avenue South shoulders. Doing some minor landscaping at the Airport by the hangers. Painting some structures at the Parks. The swimming beach buoys are being stolen and\or moved by the public.

- **City Hall Office** – Audit to Council. Working on wellness program and not much response from employees needing bio-screening. Budget worksheets are being worked on, may be different than in prior years.
